# Conditions of Play Cambria Open 3-Bowl Pairs

Date: Saturday \& Sunday June 22-23, 2024

## Venue:

Cambria Lawn Bowls Club - Joslyn Center 950 Main Street, Cambria, CA

## Entry Conditions:

Open to all members of clubs affiliated with SWD, PIMD, Bowls USA, World Bowls.
Entry Fee: $\$ 320$ per team
Dress Code: Club shirts or matching team shirts (no t-shirts)
Practice: The club is open for practice on Friday, June 21, 2024 9:00 am - 4:30 pm

## Format:

Three-bowl pairs. Seven total 14-end games, four games on day one, three on day two. Finals 14 end games with top two teams play for first and second and next two teams play for third and fourth. Two sections of 8 teams with partial seeding.

Length of Games: No time limit on games.

## Scoring:

Award 3 points for a game win, 1 for a tie, 10 plus/minus points maximum A bye, if necessary, is a game won, and the team will receive an average winning score for that round.

## Trial Ends:

Two bowls in each direction per player for the first game each day, only.

## Restriction of movement of players:

Leads: No visits to the head
Skips: After first bowl
Note: When a skip goes to the mat to deliver their first bowl, their direct opponent may remain in the head before delivering their own first bowl.

## Re-spotting (Burnt End):

In the event of a burnt end, the jack will be re-spotted on the 2-meter mark on the centerline.

## Substitutions:

Substitutes must be identified and approved by the Tournament Director before the start of any game. In the event of an unexpected injury or illness, the Tournament Director may approve a substitute that was not announced before the start of a game. No substitute may play in the position of skip.

Determination of Winners: Team with highest total of game points wins.

## Tiebreaker:

If two or more teams have the same number of game points after all games have been played, the following tiebreaker will be used:

- Total plus points
- Head-to-head result, if any
- Fewest opponents' points allowed
- Most ends won
- One-end roll-off


## Prizes:

$1^{\text {st }}$ Place: $\$ 2100$
2nd Place: $\$ 1250$
3 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$ Place: $\$ 800$
$4^{\text {th }}$ Place: $\$ 450$
Dispute/emergency committee: Tournament Directors or Umpires (playing or nonplaying)

## Late arrivals:

A penalty of one point and one end played will be assessed for each ten minutes after the official start time. A late arrival of 30 minutes or more will result in forfeiture of that game. This rule may be waived in extenuating circumstances.

## Smoking/drinking policy:

There is NO smoking allowed anywhere at the facility.
