- Open to male **members** in good standing of **BowlsUSA** or affiliated with any National or International organizations.
- No byes, if possible, in the first round. First round winners become the Murray flight, and first round losers become the Allison flight. **Losers of their second game move to a Challenge Flight, with 2nd round losers in the Murray Flight playing 2nd round losers in the Allison Flight.** Knockout from there in all three flights, i. e. subsequent losses mean elimination, except for the 3rd/4th place match in the Murray and Allison flights. Three games will likely be **required** on Saturday and, in a few cases, on Sunday. If more than 32 entries, some players will play four games on day 1.
- This is one of the *points tournaments*, which means that the Winners will receive points towards the SW Division's Team Southwest.

Please **bring your own lunch** to all Division events. Hospitality will be provided by host clubs, consisting of limited hot and/or cold beverages and a small sweet on arrival, limited salads and a small dessert for lunch. Soft drinks will be available for purchase. Do not expect host clubs to provide enough food for either breakfast or lunch - that is your responsibility.

- Deadline for receipt of entries is **Mon., March 14, 2016...** Please enter in a timely fashion, allowing ample time for mail delivery. It is possible that the last entry will be refused if the field is uneven. **\$25 per player.**
